- II. Common Core Funding Projects – 1) Network Infrastructure:
 - Time Warner has upgraded network connection speed at CV, Portola, Yorba and Handy
 - Switches & access points into every classroom, cabling & wireless standard
 - Title I: E-Rate funding through free/reduced families
 - CC monies will upgrade all other schools – non-Title I
 - Ultimate goal – infrastructure is all common throughout district sites
 - Timeline is summer 2014 – 23 sites total
 - Outside access points have not been addressed yet, but will be reviewed

- 2) iTeach: <http://eclass.orangeusd.org/iTeach/index.asp>
 - Teachers will apply for program – TK-12 grade; 8 week training
 - 3 cohorts of 10 teachers per year
 - Each teacher will receive 8 iPads and keyboards with cases
 - Teacher selection will be based on applications, principal recommendations, the needs of the school site, and the needs of the teacher
 - Goal is to have at least one teacher from each site involved in program

- 3) Sat. Technology Conference
 - Scheduled for February 1, 2014
 - Incentive for teachers – raffle for an iPad. The iPad will be OUSD property and will stay with the teacher as long as teaching in the classroom in OUSD

- III. 2013-2014 E-Rate Project - Overview, Timeline and Input
 - 2013-2014 E-Rate project – Federal program based on free/reduced applications
 - Telephone funding district-wide - 64% E-Rate Federal funding; 50% CTF state funding; OUSD pays 18%
 - Currently 5,500 – 6,500 devices connected to our bandwidth
 - Expect 2-3 times as many devices in the next two years
 - Goal – Increase bandwidth with the flexibility to further increase bandwidth with

- a phone call
- Projected timeline – July 2014
- Trying to prepare by instituting for users, 1 device log-on at a time to prevent multiple device log-on to bandwidth and slowing down the network
