- 3. Describe any other community or business activities in which you have participated. Describe your roll and whether your work was volunteer or employment-related.

My service to my community is currently done through church. I am on rotation as a Sunday school teacher, serve as a Deacon and help wherever I am needed. My service to education continues in my role in the Laguna Beach Unified School District. I support the Superintendent and Board and understand the current issues and topics facing education, including California State Standards, the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF), the value of professional development for all staff, and more.

4. Why do you want to be a school board member?

I have lived in the OUSD community for 21 years, having children in the schools from 1993 – 2011. I hope to watch my grandchildren attend OUSD schools and believe in the quality education that students are provided through excellent teachers and quality learning environments that my students enjoyed for the majority of their school years. I also believe there is work to be done and that I can provide a non-biased approach that values effective practices and transparent communication. I have no additional political ambitions, nor do I wish to play "gotcha" with anyone. I am convinced in the greatness of the district and my only desire is to contribute to its continued and growing success.

5. What do you see as the basic purpose of the public schools?

Students need the skills to succeed in college and/or the workforce and should be guided by teachers and counselors to help them reach their full potential. It is our responsibility as educators, support staff, and Board members to contribute to the creation of global citizens who have the ability to become important contributors to our Democratic society.

6. What is the role of the school board in the fulfillment of that purpose?

The Board must ensure that the District represents the interests of its communities. The Board must establish responsible governance, support district priorities and goals, uphold Board policies, and understand district programs. The Board works with the Superintendent to set the direction of the district, which should be focused on student learning and achievement. The Board is responsible for hiring a Superintendent who guides the District's mission and vision in an effective and efficient manner.

7. How does the board's role differ from that of the superintendent?

The superintendent oversees the day-to-day operations of the district. The Board approves the direction and structure of the district. It ensures accountability to the public for academic achievement, financial records, budget priorities, strategic planning, and more. In addition the Board serves as the appeals body in accordance with law, Board policies, and negotiated agreements.

8. What should be the relationship between the board members and the administration in the handling of school concerns?

It is my belief that the majority of school concerns brought forward by Board members should be directed to the Superintendent, or in their absence a designee, who in turn will refer the concern to the appropriate staff member for investigation and response. I believe this helps to alleviate undue stress and keeps the superintendent apprised of all issues, as well as providing all Board members with the same information.

9. Briefly describe your commitment to public education and our school district.

I believe in a quality public education for all students. As previously noted, all my children attended OUSD schools. I have served as a Fun-Run Chair, PTA President, Booster President, Booster parent, basketball score keeper, team chaperone, and much more, all in the name of providing my children and all of the classmates with the best possible experience at each school. I continue to sing the praises of OUSD to my friends

and neighbors and encourage them all to become involved in any way they can and to look for the positive attributes within the schools their children attend.

10. What do you see as the strengths of the school district?

OUSD has made strong academic progress over the last several years.
