Use of Facilities: Field and Facility Maintenance Management

The Superintendent or designee shall be, in cooperation with the Orange Youth Council, the primary Group A user representative, establish a bad weather, limited and rotational use policy, wherein a qualified District representative appointed by the school administrator, jointly with an Orange Youth Council representative appointed by its president, shall determine bad weather use guidelines and notification procedures, i.e., no field use within 24 hours of excessive rainfall (to be determined). Furthermore, the District in cooperation with Orange Youth Council shall establish a limited and rotational use policy wherein the fields of the District shall have restricted use on Sunday and rotational use during the year, thereby allowing for rejuvenation periods.

In cooperation with Orange Youth Council, the District shall determine which fields will be withdrawn from the available field use pool, when fields will be withdrawn and for what period fields will be withdrawn, thereby establishing an economic maintenance schedule and rejuvenation period. It is also established that no permanent goal posts or fencing may be installed on District property other than that installed by the District. Any current permanent goal posts or fencing not in accord with this policy shall be removed.

In accord with the Scheduling Management Policy, the District, in cooperation with other local governmental bodies to which a Joint Facilities Use Agreement has been agreed, shall establish a cooperative maintenance agreement wherein field maintenance is centralized with economic support from the cooperative entity, thereby consolidating field maintenance with either the District or the City.
