

StudentsAcademic Load

Twelfth grade students shall be enrolled in at least five courses each semester, or the equivalent number of courses per quarter, except for students enrolled in any of the following:

1. Regional occupation programs.
2. Regional occupation centers.
3. Community college courses.
4. Independent study.
5. Special education programs where the student's individualized education program establishes a different number of courses.
6. Continuation education classes.
7. Work experience education program approved under Article 7 (commencing with Section 51760) of Chapter 5 of Part 28.
8. Any course of study authorized by the Board which is equivalent to the approved high school course of study. (cf. 6146 et seq. - Graduation Requirements/Standards of Proficiency) (cf. 6158 - Independent Study) (cf. 6174 - Continuation Education)

Assignment to Teachers and Classes

In general, students will be placed at the grade level to which they are best adjusted academically, socially and emotionally. Every effort will be made to place students with teachers to facilitate a positive student-teacher relationship.

Assignment for individuals eligible for placement under the “Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act” program will be made by the eligibility and planning team according to the procedures established in the local comprehensive plan. No individual may be required to participate in any special class or program under the local comprehensive plan unless the parent or guardian is informed of the facts which make participation in the special program necessary or desirable and the parent or guardian consents in writing to such participation. After consultation with a member of the eligibility and planning team, such consent may be withdrawn at any time.

It is the desire of the Board that special education students be placed in the least restrictive environment possible considering the student's individualized needs at the time of placement. It is expected that continuous evaluation will maintain this policy for each student.
