





We ask the parents to carefully select pants and shorts that fit properly and have a *tailored uniform appearance*, like "Dockers" style. Please avoid the "sagging" pants look that is the popular streetwear. Other stores that may sell bottomwear: Nordstrom, Macy's, JC Penny, Sears, Target, Wal-Mart, Kohl's, or Dennis Uniform Company.

Uniform Policy, "At-a-Glance"

*A polo shirt with **CV embroidered or screen print logo** available in white, navy, forest green and burgundy. These will be available from J&M Promotions. *Uniform pants, skirt, skort, shorts, capris are plain navy blue (no denims or denim look-a-likes of any color). Athletic pants/ shorts are not permitted. They must be an appropriate size and length, must fit at the waist and crotch, and must be worn at the waistline. Corduroy and cotton twill are also acceptable. *All bottom wear must have sewn hems with no side seam slits. No frayed, pinned, staples, or tapered pants. No holes or tears.

*All skirts, shorts and skorts must be at the least mid-thigh length.

*Belts ate required if the shorts or pants do not stay at the waist without one.

Uniform Waiver Information

*Waivers will be required of all students who do not wear the designated school uniform as described above.

*Applications and appointments with the assistant principal for a waiver are available in the Student Services Office beginning **August 13, 2012**.

*Students on waiver will be required to adhere to the dress code adopted for the 12-13 school year.
