TAFT ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DRESS CODE

All Taft students are expected to follow the school uniform policy. We encourage parents and students to participate in the uniform program, studies have shown a school wide uniform policy helps support a more positive and productive learning environment for all students.

However, if you prefer that your child not wear a uniform, please stop by the Taft office and pick-up a **Uniform Waiver**.

The uniform dress code is as follows:

Boys:

Navy blue and/or khaki pants and shorts

Blue jeans (no holes, colors, skinny or baggy jeans)

Navy blue, light blue, white or red polo shirts

White button-down shirts

Girls:

Navy blue and/or khaki pants, shorts, skorts and jumpers **Blue jeans (no holes, colors, skinny or baggy jeans)**Navy blue, light blue, white or red polo shirts
White blouses

NOTE: Pants and shorts must be size/length appropriate, fitting at the waist and crotch. No baggy styles are permitted. Shirts must have collars. No tank tops or sleeveless tops are allowed. Students must wear close toe, school appropriate shoes (i.e. tennis shoes).

**Fridays are designated as "School Spirit Days" when students may wear uniforms or uniform pants with Taft spirit wear tops. No other logo shirts are to be worn.
